

Summary of Vibracore 8

This entire sequence is represented by a mixed terrigenous and carbonate coarse sand. The sediments are quartz-rich and have no apparent bedding or other sedimentary structures. Broken shells comprise a significant portion of the coarse sand fraction. No evidence of early diagenesis is apparent.
