Jet Probe      Site Position

Notes

P20      26° 05' 49"N  
          80° 05' 42"W

The sand is spotty and white-yellow in color. Coral cobbles up to 6" in diam. are mixed in the sand and are strewn on the surface.

P21      26° 05' 49"N  
          80° 05' 37"W

A dense cover of coral chunks of cobble and boulder size (up to 12 inches) characterizes the bottom at this point. Coral knobs pierce the surface in many places.

P22      26° 05' 48"N  
          80° 05' 33"W

The bottom is covered by a layer of coarse sand 8-10 inches deep. Coral knobs are scattered throughout the area. Loose coral cobbles, boulders are strewn over the bottom. Some sand in pockets was seen.

P23      26° 05' 47"N  
          80° 05' 20"W

Coarse shelly sand 3-5 ft. deep and shelly gravel characterize this site. Coral and shell pebbles and cobbles up to 2 inches in diam. are scattered on the surface. Small dead coral heads 1 ft. diam. were seen in the area. Sand cover is more even to the eastward. Large, low relief reefs were also visible.
